



GOOD FRIDAY 3 ILLUSTRATION




1. Photocopy the above image onto thin card, one for every person. If you use a light coloured card it can be coloured if desired. This goes at the top of each ribbon. Names can be written on the back to identify the owner when the activity is finished.



2. PALM SUNDAY

Palm leaf, can be cut out of any green paper, free hand or with a template. Younger children might prefer a leaf shape already cut and folded in half long ways so that they can just cut.



3. THE LAST SUPPER

Any type of cracker will work, possibly you might think rectangular are more authentic than round! If you have children with allergies you could copy photos or crackers onto card. There is no reason why the crackers need to be eaten, but experience tells me that they probably will be!

4. THE GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE

Use either a real leaf from your garden, or an artificial one from eg a wedding supplies shop.




5. JUDAS BETRAYS JESUS

If you are able to find plastic silver coins (I could only find gold) or chocolate silver coins you could use these instead of the two 5p pieces.

6. JESUS IS MOCKED BY THE SOLDIERS

A small piece of any purple fabric. Felt is more expensive but does not fray and is easy for children to cut.



7. THE CRUCIFIXION

Nails, long but not too sharp.



7.5 Dice – I found some small dice beads at Hobbycraft. These are nice to have, but not essential. There is no separate clue for these, but talk to the children about the way that the soldiers played a game to win Jesus's robe.



8. JESUS IS DYING

Small piece of sponge, depending on age/allergies etc you could have a small bowl with some vinegar in so that the sponge can be dipped . This will need to be a small amount so that the sponges just have an aroma of vinegar rather than dripping it all over the place.



9. THE BURIAL

Whole (not powdered) spices.

These are (I think) star anise, cinnamon sticks, nutmeg and cloves. Depending on price and availability, one or two types is plenty.



10. THE TOMB

A roundish pebble, not too large.
