

PUBLIC NOTICE

ST ANNE'S CHURCH

Millers Dale, Derbyshire

The Derby Diocesan Board of Finance have applied to the Charity Commission to be appointed the trustee of the church of St Anne at Millers Dale in Derbyshire where their trusteeship is not conclusive, for the property of the charity to be vested in it and to amend the trusts which are currently restriction to giving religious instruction to the following:- "To promote and assist the work and purposes of the Church of England in the Diocese of Derby including the purposes of religious education". The congregation is now very small and unable to continue to maintain the building. The church council have passed a resolution seeking closure. The Board of Finance would have the power under its proposals to sell the property and use the funds for other church purposes in the Diocese.
