

## Letter to PCC Treasurers, PCC Secretaries and Clergy

### Common Fund 2022

Dear friends ...

*'As we come to towards the end of another financial year, it is customary for the DBF to write out to give an update on common fund for the current year, along with details of the requirement for the coming year. Highlighted below is the impact of the pandemic on the Board and the Diocese as a whole, along with how the teams at Derby Church House can assist parishes as part of their own recovery planning.'*

#### How has the Covid-19 pandemic affected the Diocese finances?

In October 2019, Diocesan Synod approved the 2020 budget with a modest deficit of £0.5m and indicated a likely sustainable position by 2025. Since then, we have all been affected in so many ways by Covid-19, one of which is financial. The projected deficits between 2020 and 2026 are now forecast to be around £5.3m

The forecast position for the end of 2021 is a deficit of £1.3m. This is predominantly down to lower levels of Common Fund income than in previous pre-pandemic years. We will therefore have to dig deep into our reserves to manage this loss. It is helpful that the DBF have built resilience into its finances over the past few years in order to manage these difficult times.

#### How has the Covid-19 pandemic affected Common Fund this year?

It is remarkable that Parishes managed to offer the level of Common Fund they did in 2020, for which the Board is grateful because this ensures that we can continue to provide the resources required to support the whole mission of the Diocese. However, we realise that the impact of this pandemic has profoundly affected our life even deeper during 2021 both as a Diocese and at Parish level, along with the lives of people in our parish communities. This has meant that many parishes have found difficulty in maintaining payments against their 2021 request and pledge. We forecast that our 2021 receipts will be around £3.7m, which is £0.5m less than in 2020 and £1.0m less than in 2019.

#### What about next year and beyond?

In October 2021, Diocesan Synod approved the 2022 budget including the use of around £1.2m of reserves to bridge the gap in the loss of income and to preserve mission as we deliver against the Diocesan Vision. In order to turn around the Diocesan finances, we need to grow our income streams as reducing expenditure alone will not balance the books. We are exploring all ways to increase income, but with around 50% of our income reliant upon Common Fund, this will be a significant focus. Healthy parish finances will result in more generous Common Fund receipts, which the diocese will use to finance resources for growth. The Diocese has already begun to invest in resources to make this happen.

### **How does this relate to Common Fund requests next year?**


With increasing costs year on year, and reducing transition funding from the Church Commissioners, Common Fund becomes increasingly important to our diocesan life. We are aware that it might be difficult to commit how much you will be able to continue to give for 2022. For the realisation of the Diocesan Budget for 2022, we need to ask you to think about how much you can continue to realistically pledge as your parish hopefully starts a journey of recovery from the challenges of the past two years. We acknowledge that parishes face their own financial challenges so want to help you in any way we can, and for parishes to support one another in their benefices and deaneries, to meet the Common Fund together. Some parishes already take this approach locally. We are here to support parishes, so please be in touch if we can help.

The Parish request for 2022 was outlined in the letter to Treasurers in 2019. The calculated request for the three-year period (2020 to 2022) has had 'transitional relief' applied in order to smooth the figures over the triennium. ### **What might the future look like?**

The future of our Diocese will be determined by the financial resilience of the Board of Finance and the financial resilience of our Parishes. Our prayer is that we grow the Kingdom of God, for all ages, increase our diversity, across every geographical, socio-economic and cultural context. We can only do that with your help as we reshape our work, and our resources.

Friends, on behalf of the Board, amidst these difficult times, be of good courage and be assured of our continual prayers for you all.

A blank Standing Order mandate for Common Fund payment is attached. One copy of the Standing Order mandate should be sent to your bank, the second should be returned to the Finance Team at the Parish Support Office. If your parish cash flow makes full payment by this method unrealistic, please consider making at least part of your contribution by monthly Standing Order. Please remember that the Standing Order mandate only covers a twelve-month period so will need to be renewed annually from January each year.
