

IN THE CONSISTORY COURT OF THE DIOCESE OF DERBY

In the Matter of sections 77 and 78 of the Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction and Care of Churches Measure 2018, and the disposal of items from redundant churches

ADDITIONAL MATTERS ORDER made by the Chancellor

Whereas there may be a need to dispose of items which are in churches which are proposed to be closed for public worship or items which have been received by a church subject to the faculty jurisdiction from a church which has subsequently been closed for public worship

And having consulted the Diocesan Advisory Committee

Pursuant to the above provisions and in accordance with Rule 3.4 of the Faculty Jurisdiction Rules 2015, as amended,

I HEREBY ORDER THAT:

Where an incumbent and PCC agree that they wish to dispose of items which are located in churches which are proposed to be closed for public worship or items which have been received by a church subject to the faculty jurisdiction from a church which has subsequently been closed for public worship

PERMISSION is hereby granted for an incumbent and PCC to dispose of such items

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. The proposal to dispose of such items and the manner of disposal has first been notified to and approved in writing by the Archdeacon;
2. The value of any single such item can be evidenced as being less than £500
3. A written record of such items including photographs is to be retained by the parish and a copy filed with the Registry.

PROVIDED THAT where the conditions are not satisfied, a faculty may be sought.
