ADDITIONAL MATTERS ORDER

Whereas there may be a request for the installation of Commonwealth War Graves Commission signs in churchyards

And having consulted the Diocesan Advisory Committee

Pursuant to the above provisions and in accordance with Rule 3.4 of the Faculty Jurisdiction Rules 2015, as amended,

I HEREBY ORDER THAT:

Where an incumbent and Parochial Church Council ('PCC') agree to the installation of signage

PERMISSION is hereby granted for the Archdeacon to allow, by notice in writing, Commonwealth War Graves Commission signs to be installed in a churchyard without first obtaining a faculty

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. The installation of the sign has been the subject of a supporting resolution of the PCC
2. The sign is of a standard design recommended by the Diocesan Advisory Committee ('DAC') or adapted to the requirements of a particular location on the advice of the DAC;
3. The dimensions and location of the sign or signs have been approved by the Archdeacon who may seek the advice of the DAC, as the circumstances require;
4. The Archdeacon must retain a copy of every notice given and must also send a copy to –
 - (i) The Registrar of the Diocese for filing in the Diocesan Registry
 - (ii) The Secretary of the DAC
