The completed forms should be returned (electronically if possible) and returned to the Archdeacon's Office within seven days of the meeting at which the Warden was elected and certainly no later than **5**<sup>th</sup> **June 2024.** If a parish does not have an Incumbent or Priest in Charge or that person is on sick leave, the Chair of the APCM should sign as the chair of the meeting.
