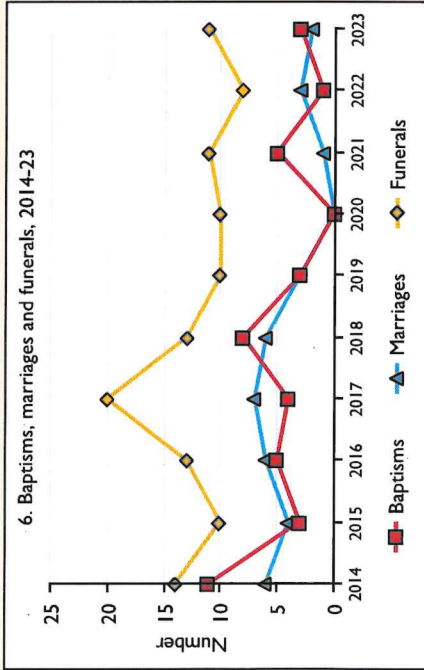

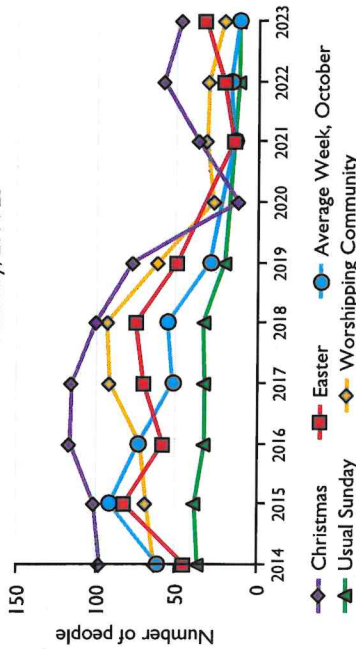

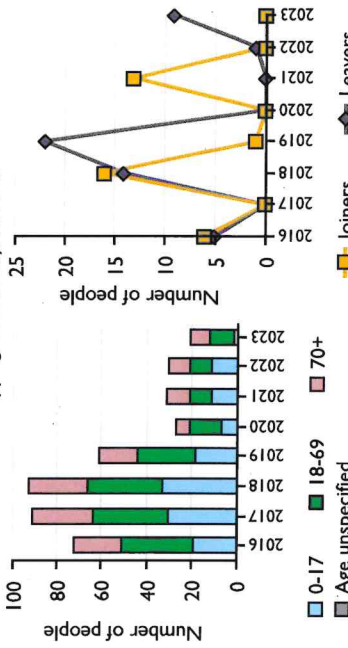

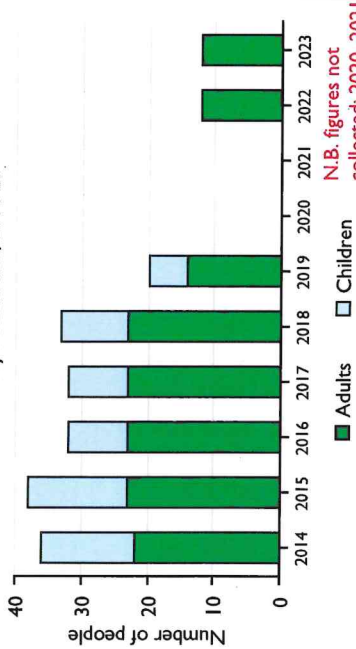
1. Attendance Summary, 2014-23



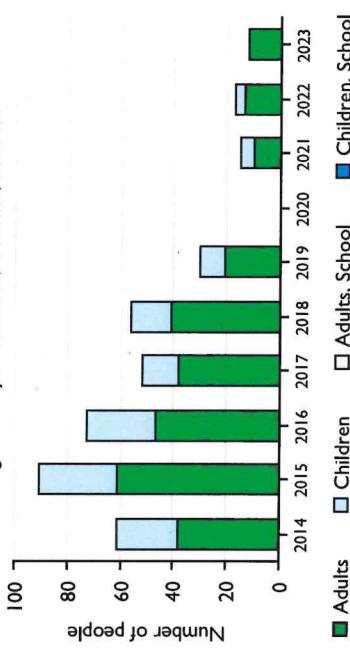
2. Worshipping Community, 2016-23



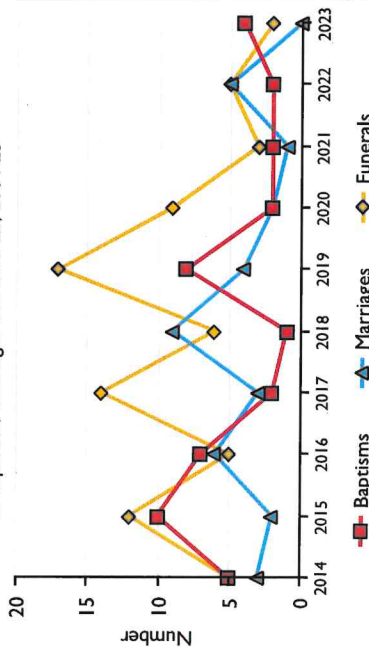
3. Usual Sunday Attendance, 2014-23

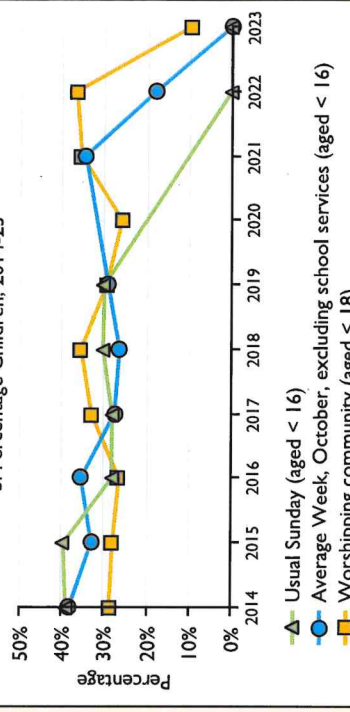
