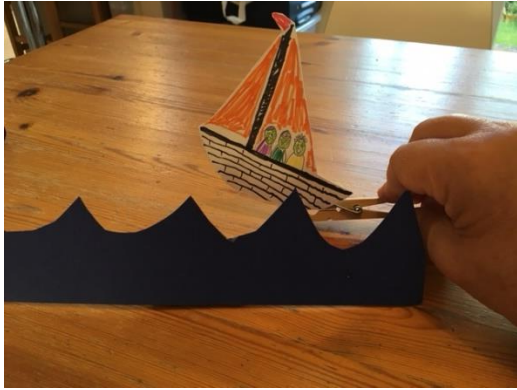


## JONAH ACTIVITIES

### 1. Boat on a rough sea.

You need:

- A clothes peg



- A card template for the boat
- Card to cut their own boat from (some will need this doing for them, others will design their own boat, but make sure there are some sailors with green faces included!)
- Dark blue card to make a rough sea on one side, it can be turned over to show a calm sea once Jonah has been thrown overboard.
- Colouring pens/pencils
- Sellotape to fix the boat to one “prong” of the clothes peg so that you can make it go up

and down by opening and closing the peg.

### 2. JONAH MEETS A BIG FISH

You will need:



- See through plastic cups
- A bradawl (or skewer) to make a hole in the bottom. **ADULT ONLY** use blu tak to stop the spike going into the table or your thumb.
- String and Sellotape – pass the string through the hole – use a big plastic needle or wrap Sellotape around the end of the string so that it goes through easily.
- A lego person or a jelly baby to be

Jonah. Tie him securely to the open cup end of the string, tie a big knot in the other end.

- Cut dark blue card into a tail and two fin shapes, and stick two eyes (available from craft shops) on.
- Now Jonah can swim around and as you pull the string he will get eaten by the fish!

### 3. JONAH'S TREE

You will need:



- Two pieces of card
- A Lolly stick
- Felt pens
- A pipe cleaner
- Hole punch

Stick the cards either side of the lolly stick. On one side draw a beautiful tree, and on the other a dead stick.

**Make some hole punch holes and thread the pipe cleaner through, this is the worm that eats Jonah's tree.**

**Talk about how Jonah felt each time!!**
