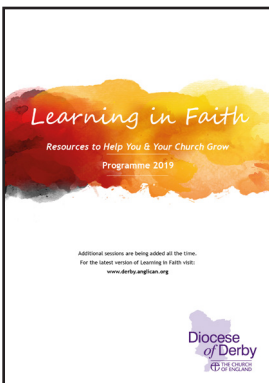
Pray also for one of their Mission Priorities, spiritual revival in the worshipping community.
