Leadership Training

The Church of England's National Safeguarding Team provides the content of Leadership training and this course is aimed at those in a Leadership role and promotes a learning journey for participants.

The Virtual Safeguarding Leadership Learning Pathway requires some pre- course work to be completed. The reason for this is that the Pathway encourages participants to engage in a process of reflective learning. The pre- course work should take approximately two hours.

This training is completed via the Church of England Training Portal where coursework, Zoom link, case study and certificates are accessed.

- Go to the CofE Training Portal
- Register or login on the portal if you have not already done so (if you have already completed Basic and Foundation portal training, you will already have an account on the Portal). You will need your previous username and password
- Click on 'online courses' where you will see the 'All Courses' screen
- Click on the Courses tab/Core Pathways/Leadership to reach Diocese of Derby 'Derby'.
- Click on 'enrol me', then we will email you as soon as possible to confirm your enrolment
- Click on 'Preparing to Learn'
- Click on 'choose a learning group' choose a date that suits your diary, make a note of the 2 dates and time (via Zoom / in-person)
- Click on 'Preparation Task'
- Complete the written and reading tasks listed on this page. Once you have completed all of the sections, use the button 'submit' to finish this section, you will not be able to join the first Zoom/In-Person session until this is done
- Join the first Groupwork session on the date you have chosen using the button with the Zoom/In-Person link shown on the portal
- Between the first and second sessions, complete the coursework task via the portal and complete the questions, use the 'submit' button to complete this section, you need to do this via the portal in order to join session 2
- Join the second Groupwork Zoom/In-person session for the 2nd session of your module
- Complete one of the final evaluation tasks and 'submit assignment'
- You will receive an email to say that your certificate is available in your profile once the Tutor has marked all parts of your participation as complete.
